Investment Objective

To provide competitive risk adjusted returns to its investors by investing in a diversified portfolio of long, medium and short term Shariah compliant debt instruments while taking in to account liquidity considerations.

Fund Manager's Comments

During the month, the fund size increased from PKR 746.11 mn to PKR 751.33 mn. The Fund made monthly annualized return of 4.96% for the month ended July 31, 2021 as compared to its benchmark return of 3.13% during the same period.
